RE: Coalition of Northeastern Governors (CONEG) Toxics Model Legislation

To Our Valued Customer:

This certification applies to all printing inks and related chemical products supplied by INX International Ink Co. (INX) during calendar year 2007.

These printing inks and related chemical products are formulated from ingredients whose chemistry excludes cadmium, hexavalent chromium, lead, and mercury. However, like all synthetic and naturally occurring chemical substances, raw materials as received from our suppliers may conceivably contain trace amounts of these metals. INX International Ink Company does not intentionally add these heavy metals to any of its ink products, and therefore INX complies with that portion of the legislation prohibiting the use of such metals.

Based on random tests of ink products produced by INX International Ink Company in the last two years and results of investigation or review of the information as provided by our suppliers, we can therefore certify that any such metals that are incidentally present in our ink products meet the 100 ppm maximum limit as specified in the CONEG toxics model legislation.

This certification releases INX International Ink Co. from any liability once the product has been removed from its original packaging or has been handled in any manner that alters its original state.
