Dear Michele,

This letter is to confirm that the kraft papers we manufacture at our Joliet, Illinois paper mill are 100% recycled kraft paper items. The 85# HWKB special kraft grade is manufactured with 50% post-consumer and 50% post-industrial recycled kraft fibers.

We use no virgin pulp in our paper mill. The kraft grades of paper are manufactured using recycled corrugated boxes and box clippings. Our raw materials are all items that are recycled and thereby avoid being sent to the land fill.


Our kraft papers are also recycle-able. All of our paper can be reprocessed in a paper recycling system, so items made with our paper have a very good chance of being recycled again.

We certify that our paper products comply with the requirements of the Toxics in Packaging Law. Specifically:

- 1) We certify that the regulated metals-lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent Chromium-were not intentionally added to the paper during our manufacturing process.
- 2) We certify that the sum of the incidental concentration levels of lead, mercury, Cadmium and hexavalent chromium present in the paper does not exceed 100 parts per million by weight.
