This letter is in response to your recent inquiry pertaining to the Reduction of Toxics in Packaging requirements.

I am please to inform you that we certify our recycled paperboard produced by our 
 mill complies with the toxics in packaging law requirements, specifically:

1.  does not add to its raw materials (recovered paper) or to its process any lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium.
2. The sum of the incidental concentration levels of lead, cadmium, mercury, and hexavalent chromium do not exceed 100 parts per million (0.01%) by weight.
